## SCHOOL NEWS, FROM MR. MEDAUGH, PRINCIPAL:

**St. Rose School website: [www.stroselimaschool.org](http://www.stroselimaschool.org).** Teachers will report for work on August 18th. Because there are now only six teachers on staff, the issues of covering all the duties become problematic. Many Catholic Schools have parent volunteers who cover some of the duties. If this is something with which you might want to help, give us a call. I am grateful that we have parish volunteers in our library. We will begin our school year with a meeting on August 19th at the church at 7:00 p.m. At the completion of that event, parents and students can tour the school and see the changes that have been made. **The first day of school will be Thursday, August 20th.**

It is easy to look at our reduction in staff at St. Rose and feel a little deflated. We are not the only Catholic school in this predicament and there are some public schools in which I have friends teaching that don’t have some of the programming we have. I have told students on occasions that we all suffer setbacks. It’s how we handle them that speaks volumes about our Faith and our character. I am encouraged by what I have seen this summer in regards to both. I also want to address two other issues.

In much of the literature I read from the diocese, parents are referred to as stakeholders. As such, I believe you have certain responsibilities to the school and that I have certain obligations to you. Many of you have probably heard that we have hired a receptionist and have done some remodeling. If you are like me, you are wondering from where all that money is coming. Outside of the actual construction, all of the paint and other labor was donated. All the items in the new reception area were donated or were items we had on hand at the schools. We just gathered it all together to make a very comfortable reception area. In regards to the receptionist position, Mrs. Medaugh took Mrs. Householder’s job as auxiliary Clerk. Those hours are paid by New Lexington City School. Mrs. Medaugh will now be working three days for New Lexington School and two days for St. Rose. The money saved in this transition allowed us to hire a part-time receptionist. I have a little book called *“God Thinks You’re Wonderful”* by Max Lucado. I bought it at a used book sale. It is filled with little ideas about our relationship with God. Among them is this thought: *“Our hearts are not large enough to contain the blessings that God wants to give so try this. The next time a sunrise steals your breath...or a meadow of flowers leave you speechless...remain that way. Say nothing and listen as heaven whispers, “Do you like it? I did it just for you.”*
