POPE FRANCIS:

THE MAGIC WORDS FOR MARRIED LIFE: Married life is such a beautiful thing, and we must treasure it always, treasure the children. There are three words that always need to be said, three words that need to be said at home; May I, thank you, and sorry. The three magic words. May I, so as not to be intrusive in the life of the spouses. May I, but how does it seem to you? May I, please allow me. Thank you, to thank one's spouse: thank you for what you did for me, thank you for this. That beauty of giving thanks! And since we all make mistakes, that other word, which is a bit hard to say, but which needs to be said: sorry. Please, thank you, and sorry. With these three words, with the prayer of the husband for the wife and vice versa, by always making peace before the day comes to an end, marriage will go forward. The three magic words, prayer, and always making peace.

Have mercy on me, God, in Your kindness. In Your compassion, blot out my offense. O wash me more and more from my guilt and cleanse me from my sin. My offenses truly I know them; my sin is always before me. Against You, You alone, have I sinned; what is evil in Your sight I have done. That You may be justified when You give sentence and be without reproach when You judge, O see, in guilt I was born, a sinner I was conceived. Indeed, You love truth in the heart; then in the secret of my heart teach me wisdom, O purify me, then I shall be clean; O wash me, I shall be whiter than snow. Make me hear rejoicing and gladness, that the bones You have crushed may revive. From my sins, turn away Your face and blot out all my guilt. A pure heart create for me, O God, put a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your presence, nor deprive me of Your holy spirit. Give me again the joy of Your help; with a spirit of fervor sustain me, that I may teach transgressors Your ways and sinners may return to You. O rescue me, God, my helper, and my tongue shall ring out Your goodness. O Lord, open my lips and my mouth shall declare Your praise. For in sacrifice, You take no delight, burnt offerings from me; You would refuse, my sacrifice, a contrite spirit, a humbled, contrite heart You will not spurn. Lord, remember Your promise of mercy, Hear the cries of Your people, as each of us cries for ourself and as all of us cry for each other; Have pity on us poor sinners.

All five screenings for \$149.00 (1) Carotid Artery/Plaque Screening – Ultrasound scan for the carotid arteries that screens for plaque buildup; (2) Heart Rhythm Screening (Atrial Fibrillation) – Screens for irregular heart beat; (3) Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Screening – Screens for an aneurysm in the abdominal aorta, which could rupture; (4) Peripheral Arterial Disease Screening – Screens for peripheral arterial disease in the lower extremities; and (5) Osteoporosis Risk Assessment – Ultrasound screen the heel bone to determine abnormal bone mass density.
