Project DAWN: It is no secret that there has been an overwhelming surge in opiate overdoses and fatalities within our communities. It is a devastating problem, and Mount Carmel wants to be part of the solution. Mount Carmel Outreach and Mount Carmel Mobile Medical Coach have joined forces with Project DAWN (Deaths Avoided With Naloxone), a community-based overdose education and Narcan (naloxone) distribution program. The project DAWN program provides Narcan kits free of charge to those without health insurance and with limited financial means. Narcan is a safe medication that can reverse an overdose caused by prescription pain medication or heroin and saves lives.
