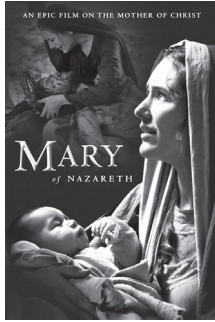

SCHOOL NEWS

FROM THE PRINCIPAL:

Thanksgiving is a time that we purposely thank God for the many blessings that He has bestowed upon us. It is also a time when families draw near to share a meal. It is a specific time designated for everyone to sit together as a family and to enjoy stories and traditions of their heritage. The family of today has a very busy schedule with after school activities and other obligations that sometimes interrupt the family mealtime. Unless families make a commitment to sharing their evening meals together, this special interaction between parents and children is lost. Children and teens especially need this family time so that family values can be taught and reinforced. Coaxing kids to defend their positions on simple things like their favorite movies or games or why attending Mass is important helps them to think on their feet and become comfortable with having a different opinion. A recent study found that teens that eat dinner with their families five to seven times a week are:

- 45% less likely to try alcohol
- 24% less likely to smoke marijuana, and
- 67% more likely to get better grades in school.

This study also found that teens were less likely to drink if they reported that they regularly attended Mass and expressed confidence in getting 'support from their parents and God' when in need.

For parents anxious about teen vulnerability, these findings confirm that a strong marriage and regular Mass attendance as a family are powerful tools to keep children out of trouble. The more that you talk with your children, the greater the possibility that they will come to talk with you when they need advice. And remind them, they can always speak to the man upstairs! 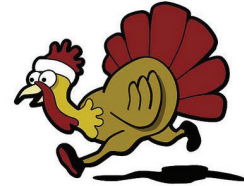
