PRESENTATION TOUR: You are invited to the Jubilee Museum, 57 S. ADVENT HIKE, ADORATION AND VIGIL MASS: This year's Wilderness Outreach Advent Hike will be held on Saturday, December 20th at Tar Hollow State Park.
