SCHOOL NEWS:

There was a recent meeting with parents, together with Dr. Joe Brettnacher, Superintendent of the Columbus Diocese Schools, and Kitty Quinn from the Diocesan Education Office, who presented the restructuring plan for sustaining St. Rose School. **Multi-Age Blended Learning** will be incorporated in St. Rose School for the 2015-2016 school year. Thanks to all St. Rose family members who were able to attend. We are working hard to provide the best Catholic education for our students. Dr. Brettnacher informed Fr. Jim that after listening to us and our concerns about class size, the following changes, which will be possible in our budget have been made to what was proposed at the meeting. Kindergarten will have 1 teacher..G1, 15 students if all current students in K move on to the next grade, will have 1 teacher.. G2(12) and G3(12)=24 will have 1 teacher...G4(17), if all students in G3 move on to the next grade, will have 1 teacher: G5(15) and G6(12)=27 will have one teacher..G7(7) and G8(12)=19 will have 1 teacher. More information will be forthcoming.

**Registrations for enrollment for the 2015-2016 school year are now being accepted. St. Rose School offers a comprehensive curriculum with a foundation in the doctrine of the Catholic Church. For Kindergarten, students must be 5 years of age by August 1st in order to be eligible to enroll.
