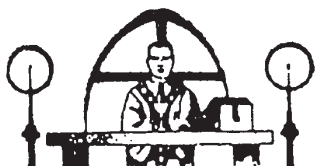

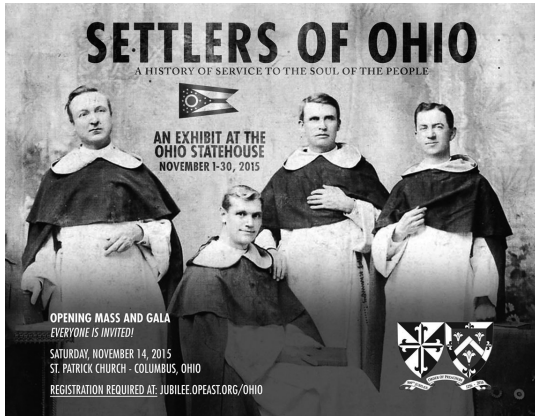

MARIA GORETTI: The sacred remains of St. Maria Goretti, Patroness of Virtue and of Mercy, will be at St. Joseph Cathedral on October 21st from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., with a special Memorial Mass celebrated at 7:00 p.m. This is a first-of-a kind visit of her remains to the United States in coordination for the Extraordinary Year of Mercy, which officially begins on December 8th. Please note, there are no "reservations" associated with this one-day opportunity – the faithful are invited equally to St. Joseph Cathedral for prayer, and veneration of the sacred remains of St. Maria Goretti.
