## POPE FRANCIS:

Those who celebrate the sacrament of Matrimony say, "I promise to be true to you, in joy and in sadness, in sickness and in health; I will love you and honor you all the days of my life." At that moment, the couple does not know what will happen, nor what joys and pains await them. They are setting out, like Abraham, on a journey together. And that is what marriage is! Setting our and walking together, hand in hand, putting yourselves in the Lord's powerful hands. Hand in hand, always and for the rest of your lives. And do not pay attention to this makeshift culture, which can shatter our lives.

## **JESUS' FIFTH BEATITUDE... "BLESSED ARE THE MERCIFUL..."**

Embodies a major part of the Christian message. The paradox is that mercy is evidently offered on the principle of stern justice. The mercy we show is precisely the mercy we receive. For most of us, this appears a little concerning. It is not easy to forgive. The human heart is petty-minded, a connate master of grudge-holding. Luke says "*Forgive and you will be forgiven/ Give and gifts will be given to you; a good measure, packed together, shaken down, and overflowing, will be poured into your lap. For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you*" (Lk 6:37-38). The picture is not of a miserly God, who weights out every ounce. God is more like a friendly grocer who stuffs as much within the measuring cup we bring as he possibly can, then heaps it up until it is spilling out. There is a real proportion between what we do and what we get; we make our own measuring cup: but such justice is always – thank God!

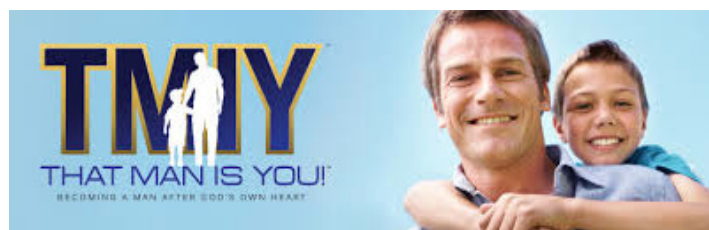
