For instance, Faustina also tells us in her diary, "Let no soul, even the most miserable, fall prey to doubt; for as long as one is alive, each one can become a great saint, so great is the power of God's grace. It remains only for us not to oppose God's action." How do we avoid opposing God's action? As St. Therese of Lisieux appeared to and told Faustina, "You must always **trust** in the Lord Jesus."
