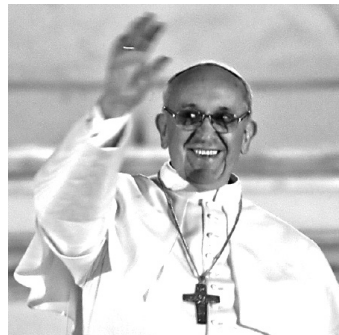

## POPE FRANCIS:

A MOTHER KNOWS WHAT'S IMPORTANT FOR HER CHILDREN. I ask myself: what does a Mother do? First of all, she teaches how to walk through life; she teaches the right path to take through life; she knows how to guide her children; she always tries to point out to them the right path in life for growing up and becoming adults. And she does so with tenderness, affection, and love, even when she is trying to straighten out our path because we are going a little astray in life or are taking roads that lead to an abyss. A mother knows what's important for a child to enable him/her to walk the right way through life. Moreover, she did not learn it from books, but from her own heart. The university of mothers is their heart! They learn there how to bring up their children...A mother never teaches what is evil; she only wants the good of her children, and so does the Church.

In Christ and through Christ, God becomes especially visible in his mercy... Christ confers on the whole of the Old Testament tradition about God's mercy a definite meaning. Not only does he speak of it and explain it by the use of comparisons and parables, but above all, he himself makes it incarnate and personifies it. He himself, in a certain sense, is mercy. To the person who sees it in him... and finds it in him...God becomes "visible" in a particular way as the Father *who is rich in mercy*.

**LATIN AMERICA COLLECTION:** Next week, August 6th-7th, we will take up the Collection for the Church in Latin America. In Peru, there are 14 villages all located away from the city center, with the most remote locations, only accessible by boat. The faithful in these communities do not have access to catechetical formation, and members often feel separated from the life of the universal Church. Through a grant from the Collection for the Church in Latin America, the religious congregation of the Missionaries of Jesus was able to provide faith formation, spiritual retreats, and workshops to nearly 250 people. Upon completion, participants were better equipped to help others deepen their faith and answer questions. The program also renewed their sense of commitment to their own families.
