EPIPHANY BLESSING OF HOMES: The Church has a custom of blessing homes on the Feast of the Epiphany and the week following. Family and friends gather to ask God's blessing on their homes and those who live in or visit the home. It is an invitation for Jesus to be a daily guest in our home, our comings and goings, our conversations, our work and play, our joys and sorrows.

A traditional way of doing this is to use chalk blessed during the Epiphany liturgy and write above the home's entryway

The individual cards will be for the parishioners to use for this occasion. The parishes will provide the chalk that will be blessed and attached to the cards.
